INSTALLING BATTERY



OPERATION GUIDE



	Function	Operation
1.	Power	Press and hold 1 for two seconds to turn ON/OFF.
2.	Mode Selection	Press and hold 3 to choose between Metronome and Tone Generator modes.
3.	Metronome Mode	Once in Metronome mode, press 1 to start. Press 2 to change rhythm style, or 3 to adjust beats per measure. Buttons 4 / 5 adjust tempo speed from 30-260. Press 1 again to pause.
4.	Tone Generator Mode	Once in Tone Generator mode, press 1 to start. Use 2 / 3 to change notes, or 4 / 5 to calibrate pitch. Press 1 again to pause.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If the Metronome begins behaving unusually, turn the power off, remove batteries, then put them back in and turn the power back on.

If the display fades, please replace the batteries with new ones.
